"Secondly, everyone in the class likes to sing. We are of varying abilities, and coming from different perspectives, but everyone is enthusiastic, and it's fun to sing with others in such a setting.

"Lastly, the songs, themselves, are both lovely and varied; they are ones that we're unlikely to learn anywhere else. They are mainly songs of the Celtic tradition. My favorites are the sad and beautiful Irish and Scottish songs of love and loss. But Shay teaches a huge variety of songs from a seemingly bottomless repertoire, including Scots fighting songs, sea chanteys, political and historical songs, Child ballads, emigration songs, and contemporary folk songs. There are songs for all tastes.
